# Supplies & Preparation Sheet

### Homework to Prepare for Lesson 3

Gather the cowl materials

- 1 skein Cloudborn Superwash Merino Worsted Twist (100% superwash merino wool; 220 yds per 100 g skein); sample uses color Lavender Heather
- US 7 (4.5 mm) 16" (40 cm) circular needle
- Stitch marker

 Work the body of the cowl, right up to the ribbing per pattern instructions.

# Homework to Prepare for Lesson 5

### **CHOOSE A STYLE & SIZE**

- Decide what size and style you want to make. You can make a fitted hat or a slouchy one.
- If you can, measure the circumference of the head that is to wear the hat.

- For a fitted, beanie style hat, choose a size about 2" (5 cm) smaller around in circumference than your head.
- For a slouchy hat, choose a size close to the actual size of your head. If you can't measure the head, use the table below as a guideline.

#### **GATHER THE MATERIALS FOR THE HAT**

- 1 (2, 2, 2) skeins Cloudborn Superwash Merino Worsted Twist (100% superwash merino wool; 220 yds per 100 g skein); sample uses color Stormy Skies
- US 4 (3.5 mm) 16" (40 cm) circular needle or needle 2 sizes smaller than gauge needle
- US 6 (4 mm) 16" (40 cm) circular needle
- US 6 (4 mm) needles or size needed to get gauge for small circumference in the round: DPNs OR long circular for magic loop method
- Cable needle
- Stitch marker

### **SWATCH FOR THE HAT**

**Note:** Hat gauge is 20 sts/28 rounds over 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch on larger needle, after blocking.

Using US 6 (4 mm) needles, cast on 30 stitches.

Lower Edge: Knit 4 rows.

Body of Piece Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until piece measures about 3" (7.6 cm).

Upper Edge: Knit 4 rows.

Bind off and wash the swatch: gentle machine wash or handwash, lay flat to dry without stretching.

Measure swatch, decide on needles.

#### **WORK THE HAT CUFF**

Using the smaller 16" (40 cm) circular needle and the long-tail method, cast on 104 (112, 120, 128) stitches. Place marker and join for working in the round.

Ribbing round: (K1, p2, k1) around.

Work Ribbing as set until cuff measures 1.5 (1.5, 1.75, 1.75)" / 3.8 (3.8, 4.4, 4.4) cm

### **GATHER MATERIALS FOR MITTENS**

- 2 skeins Cloudborn Superwash Merino Worsted Twist (100% superwash merino wool; 220 yds per 100 g skein) – 1 each in Main Color and Contrast Color; sample uses color Plum Heather for Main Color and Ocean for Contrast Color
- US 7 (4.5 mm) needles for small circumference in the round: DPNs OR long circular for magic loop method
- Stitch markers
