### Yarn

30 yards (27.5 m) of worsted weight yarn.

### Shown In

Knit Picks "Wool of the Andes Worsted Yarn," 100 percent Peruvian Highland Wool, 1.75 ounces (50 g), 110 yards (100 m).

**Finished sample:** #24274 Lullaby. **Working sample:** #25068 Wonderland Heather.

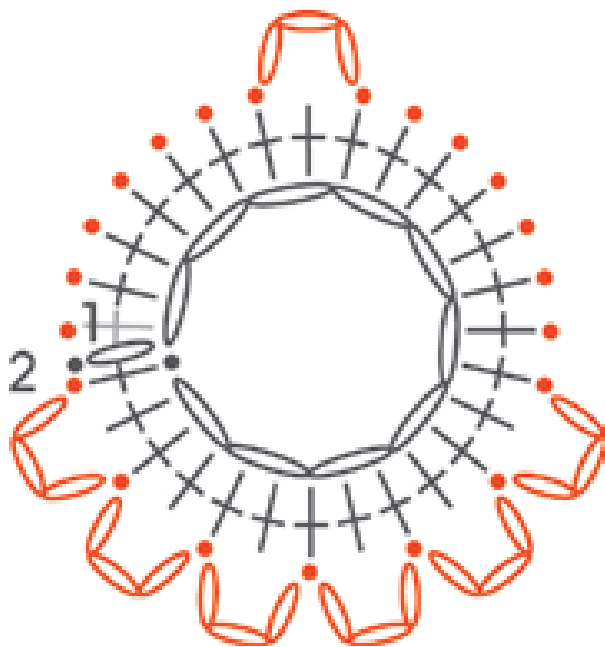

### Gauge

Gauge is not critical for this project. Refer to finished dimensions to check gauge.

### Supplies

- Size G-6 (4.0mm) crochet hook, or any size to produce desired results
- Yarn needle
- Two pair ear wires
- Straight-nose pliers



### Finished size

Hoops measure about 3" long.

### Hoops

- Ch 10, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
- **Round 1:** Ch 1, 28 sc in ring, join with sl st in first sc – 28 sc.
- **Round 2:** [Ch 3, sk next sc, sl st in next sc] 6 times, sl st in next 7 sc, ch 3, sk next sc, sl st in next sc, sl st in remaining 7 sc – 7 ch-3 loops.
- Fasten off.

### Finishing

Carefully weave in the ends. Use needle-nose pliers to open ring of ear wire and slide through the top-most ch-3 space. Close ring.
