



GENERAL SUPPLY LIST

Must haves:

- Cutting mat 24" x 36" (61 x 91.4 cm)
- Clear ruler made for rotary cutting 6" x 24" (15.2 x 61 cm)
- Rotary cutter
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Scissors
- Spray starch (I'm using Mary Ellen's Best Press)
- 50 wt cotton sewing thread for piecing, neutral color
- 50 wt cotton sewing thread for machine quilting in desired color
- Sewing machine in good working condition
- Sewing machine needles size 80/12 Microtex sharps (I am using Schmetz)
- Sewing machine quilting needles size 90
- Batting at least 8" (20.3 cm) larger on both sides than finished quilt - in other words, if quilt finishes 60" x 70" (152.4 x 177.8 cm), batting should measure at least 68" x 78" (172.7 x 198.1 cm)

Recommended:

- 1/4" patchwork sewing machine foot
- Kwik-Klip tool for helping to pin baste
- 505 Spray and Fix basting spray if spray basting
- Curved safety pins if pin basting

For machine quilting:

- Machine walking foot

For tying quilt:

- Embroidery floss in desired color; I'm using Aurifil 6-ply

For hand quilting:

- Thread for hand quilting in desired color; I use YLI 100% glazed cotton quilting thread, 40 wt, 3 ply
- Hand-quilting needle size 9 or 10
- Quilting hoop; I am using a Q-Snap 11" x 17" PVC frame
